

ALBERT GALLATIN SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL APPLICATION FOR STUDENT DRIVING AND PARKING

Although it is strongly recommended that students use the districts free bus transportation, it is recognized that some students may choose to drive private vehicles to school due to work, medical, legal or school sponsored (i.e. extracurricular) commitments. Students driving and parking on school property is a privilege and not a right.

Use of the parking lot is limited to students who possess a valid PA driver's license and who have applied for and received a parking permit.

The School Board recognizes that the safety of pedestrians and drivers on campus is Paramount. The School Board also recognizes that motor vehicles can be utilized by students in possession, sale, storage or transportation of illegal substances, devices and objects, such as drugs, alcohol stolen goods or weapons. The School District's obligation is to maintain a safe, healthy, and productive educational environment, may therefore at times require the search of motor vehicles driven by students onto school property. The search of a motor vehicle by a school official will be in accordance with the District's search policy.

Students will be charged \$50.00 for the school year for up to two (2) parking permits.

Parking fee may be paid either in full at the beginning of the school year or \$25.00 each semester. Fee is non refundable if student has his or her parking permit suspended or revoked for any reason. Students who have a parking permit suspended will receive a new permit at the end of their suspension at no charge to them.

Students who do not obtain a parking permit, but for some reason need to bring a vehicle to school may obtain a one day permit at a cost of \$1.00 per day. They will need to present their drivers license and valid insurance card to obtain a one day permit.

For the last month of school, students who wish to drive after April 29, 2016 may apply for a permit for the remainder of the school year at a cost of \$10.00.

Students applying for a parking permit must bring with the application and fee, a valid PA driver's license, valid owner's card and valid insurance card for each vehicle listed on permit application. Upon being granted parking permit, permit will be displayed on the inside of right lower windshield.

Students may register up to two (2) vehicles. In the event of an emergency situation that the student drives a vehicle not listed on permit application, student must stop at the parking lot gate and obtain an emergency permit to be displayed on the rear view mirror facing outward, there will not be a charge for this permit.

Fees are due by September 8, 2015, for the first semester, and January 4, 2016, for the second semester. Payments for parking permits may be made by cash, check or money order payable to Albert Gallatin School District. Returned checks will result in a returned check charge of \$ 45.00 and suspension of students parking permit until the check is made good.

After September 8, 2015 and January 4, 2016, students will still be able to apply for a permit, with payment due at time of application, before parking any vehicle on school property. Permits after September 8, 2015 will be issued only on Tuesdays and Thursdays during students lunch period, or after school dismissal any day.

Students shall not park a vehicle on school property without a valid parking permit being displayed after the grace period at the beginning of each semester.

Students parking on school property without a valid parking permit will receive a parking ticket, with a fine of \$5.00, failure to pay fine within five days of being issued, a parking citation under section 3353 b 1 of Title 75 PA Motor Vehicle Code will be issued with a fine of up to \$50.00 plus court cost, and may also result in students vehicle being towed at their expense.

SENIOR PARKING DISCOUNT

Seniors who have passed the KEYSTONE EXAMS IN MATH AND READING before their senior year will received a free parking permit if they have passed both, or a ½ discount (\$25.00 fee) if they have passed one.

Note: Driving to school is a privilege, not a right. Abuse this privilege, and you will lose it! Please adhere to the parking rules and regulations, as well as all school policies and rules. Paid fees are not refundable if permit is revoked during the year.
